Plant Tour Options

Alcoa Deschambault Plant Tour (1 Day)

The Alcoa Deschambault aluminium smelter is located on the Chemin du Roy, approximately 2.5 hours from Montréal. Deschambault, with a production capacity of 253,000 MT per annum is a centre of excellence with technical performance that sets an international benchmark.

Rio Tinto Alcan Saguenay Tour (1 Day)

Located in the magnificent region of the Saguenay River, one hour's flight from Montréal, four Rio Tinto Alcan facilities jointly produce more than 1 MT aluminium per annum and 3000 MW of installed capacity hydropower. This plant tour option includes a tour of two of the smelters. The cost of this tour is Can\$ 700 pp, including flight, and with numbers limited to 12 persons, early booking is advised.

IRSST Lab Tour (1/2 day)

The Institut de Recherche Robert-Sauvé en Santé et en Sécurité du Travail (IRSST) is a scientific research organization known for the quality of its work and the expertise of its personnel. The laboratories of IRSST provide world class services in environmental, toxicological and microbial analyses, sampling and calibration for public and private enterprises.

University of Montréal Lab Tour (1/2 Day)

Located on the northern slope of the Mont-Royal Park is the Université de Montréal. Comprising more than sixty departments and two affiliated schools, the university offers more than 650 undergraduate and graduate programmes making it the second largest university in Canada. The occupational hygiene laboratories of the Department of Environmental and Occupational Health are used to perform research in the occupational hygiene field and to teach the master program in environmental and occupational health. Research includes evaluations of exposures to several contaminants using environmental, personal or biological monitoring.
